1. The rules of the USTA and the Code of Conduct shall govern play. A point penalty system will be in effect at all times. Participants can incur penalty points, games or matches for unsportsmanlike conduct. The use of profanity will result in a default from tournament and loss of entry fee. Penalties shall be issued by the tournament director or committee members.
2. The draw will be done by Friday, May 14th at noon. All players must be ready to play at the time their matches are scheduled. Fifteen minutes beyond the scheduled match time without prior notice will result in a default.
3. In case of default, entry fees will not be refunded.
4. Each match will be best of three sets, regular scoring. A twelve-point tiebreaker will be used at six all. Player will be allowed a seven minute warm-up.
5. All participants should wear appropriate tennis attire/claycourt shoes.
6. The tournament committee reserves the right to change divisions containing low enrollment. No substitutions are permitted without the director's approval.
7. Participants will be required to play more than one match per day on weekends.
8. Those who lose in the first round will get one consolation match scheduled at a later date.
9. Consolation match will be played as one 8 game pro-set.

6. The tournament committee reserves the right to change divisions containing low enrollment. No substitutions are permitted without the director's approval.
